



Arwine Page

Arwine Page was born August 10, 1837 in Smith County, Tennessee and died October 7, 1907 in Dekalb County, Tennessee. He was a son of Jacob Page (1794-1849) and Jane Allen (1804-?).

On February 23, 1857 he married Amanda A Trapp. She was born July 21, 1837 in Dekalb County, Tennessee and died August 15, 1904 in Dekalb County, Georgia. She was a daughter of John Trapp (1809-1881) of White County, Tennessee and Susan McGinnis (1814-1881).

Arwine Page fought on the Union side in the Civil War in Company F, 4th Regiment, Tennessee Mounted Infantry. He survived the war and raised a large family.

Arwine and Amanda had the following children: John Allen (1858), Mary Jane (1861), William L (1864), James Lee (1868), Arwine Peyton (1873), Charles D (1877) and Tony Alfred (1879).

Arwine Page was buried at Minnie Trapp cemetery and was later disinterred and relocated at Mt Holly cemetery. His son, Charles D Page, was present at his disinterment.
