



### Henry (Carter) Carder

**Henry Carder was born January 27, 1879 and died December 11, 1898. He was a son of Asa C Carder (1852-1928) and Mary T Robinson (1842-1925), both of Dekalb County.**

**Their children in addition to Charles were William M Carder (1875), Minnie Carder (1878), and Claude (1884). Claude and his wife, Alta Mitchell, were buried at Gordonsville cemetery in Smith County, Tennessee.**

**Mary T Robinson's mother, Frances Robinson (1805-1887) was still living with Asa and Mary according to the 1880 Federal Census. She was 75 years old. She lived to be 82. She was the wife of John Riley Carder (1838-1906). They are buried at Pisgah Methodist Church cemetery on Hannah's Branch. Their name is spelled CarDer on their monument.**

**John Riley Carder was the son of old Asa Carder and Sarah Gunter. Every generation of Carders had an "Asa."**

**Henry Carder left little documentation. He died in his 19<sup>th</sup> year according to his tombstone (it is broken). The record of his disinterment from Alpha Watson cemetery gives his birth and death dates as 1897-1898. But his tombstone says 1879-1898, and he was 1 year old in the 1880 census. He was relocated at Mt Holly cemetery. A Mrs Callie Green was present at his disinterment.**
