



Jermiah Coggin

Jermiah Coggin was born in Montgomery County, North Carolina on December 24, 1798 and died December 26, 1874 in Dekalb County, Tennessee. He was the son of Burrell T Coggin (1768-1814) and Letha Tucker (1773-1847).

About 1820 he married Mary Ann Nancy Osborne. She was born in 1799 in North Carolina and died about 1850 in Dekalb County, Tennessee. Her parents are presently unknown.

Jermiah and Mary Ann had at least seven children: Burrell Titus (1825), Cynthia Jane (1827), George R (1830), Sarah A (1832), Nancy A O (1834), Martha A (1836) and Rebecca (1838).

Jermiah was a slave owner, as were some of his siblings.

Jermiah and many of his children and other relatives were originally buried at Jerrimah Coggin Heirs cemetery. They were relocated at Mt Holly cemetery. Noone was listed as present at the disinterment.
