



Patrick Cleburne Pack

Patrick Cleburne Pack was born January 2, 1870 and died January 11, 1890. He was the son of William Matthew Pack (1838-1910) and Sarah Cantrell (1837-1917).

His grandfather was Captain John Pack, a casualty of the Civil War. His father William Matthew must have been an admirer of the great men of the Confederacy as he names his two sons after Confederate generals.

Patrick Cleburne was first born. He lived just twenty years. His brother, Felix Zollicoffer Pack was born in 1873 and named for the East Tennessee general of that name. His sisters were Melvina Millie (1872) and Nancy C (1877).

Patrick Cleburne Pack was buried at Heirs of Martha Pack Cemetery, and was later disinterred and relocated at Mt Holly Cemetery. His brother Felix Zollicoffer was present at the disinterment.
