



Sarah Nancy (Pack) Stewart

Sarah Nancy Pack was born July 22, 1821 in Warren County, Tennessee and died August 17, 1908 in Dekalb County, Tennessee. She was the daughter of Bartemus Pack (1795-1874) of North Carolina and Mary Bain (1796-1870) of Virginia.

On May 19, 1866 she married Pennell Stewart of South Carolina. He was born Sept. 2, 1808 and died Jan. 9, 1892. He had been married once before he married Sarah. His first wife, Laura L Mullican was born about 1823 and died between 1860 and 1870. Laura was 15 years younger than Pennell. Sarah was about 13 years younger than Pennell.

They had four children: William (1842), Rafsee (1849), Jason (1857) and Sylvanus (1859). In addition some of Pennell's children from his first marriage lived with them.

They were originally interred at Heirs of Martha Pack Cemetery, and later were relocated at Mt Holly Cemetery. Mary Johnson, a niece, was present at the disinterment.
