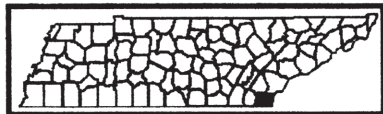

Polk County is located in the extreme south eastern corner of the state of Tennessee. It is bounded on the east by the state of North Carolina, on the south by the state of Georgia. The Tennessee counties of McMinn and Monroe form its northern boundaries. It is joined to Bradley County on the west, from which most of the county was formed in 1839. The section north of the Hiwassee River was formerly a part of McMinn County.



In May of 2000, we purchased a pretty little native stone house at the corner of Poplar and Commerce Street a block east of the Courthouse in Benton and turned it into what we like to think is one of the best little genealogy libraries around. Kept open by volunteers, our hours are Monday, Wednesday, Friday and Saturday from 11 a. m. to 3 p. m.
