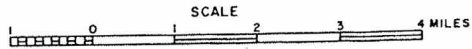


GENERAL HIGHWAY MAP DECATUR COUNTY TENNESSEE

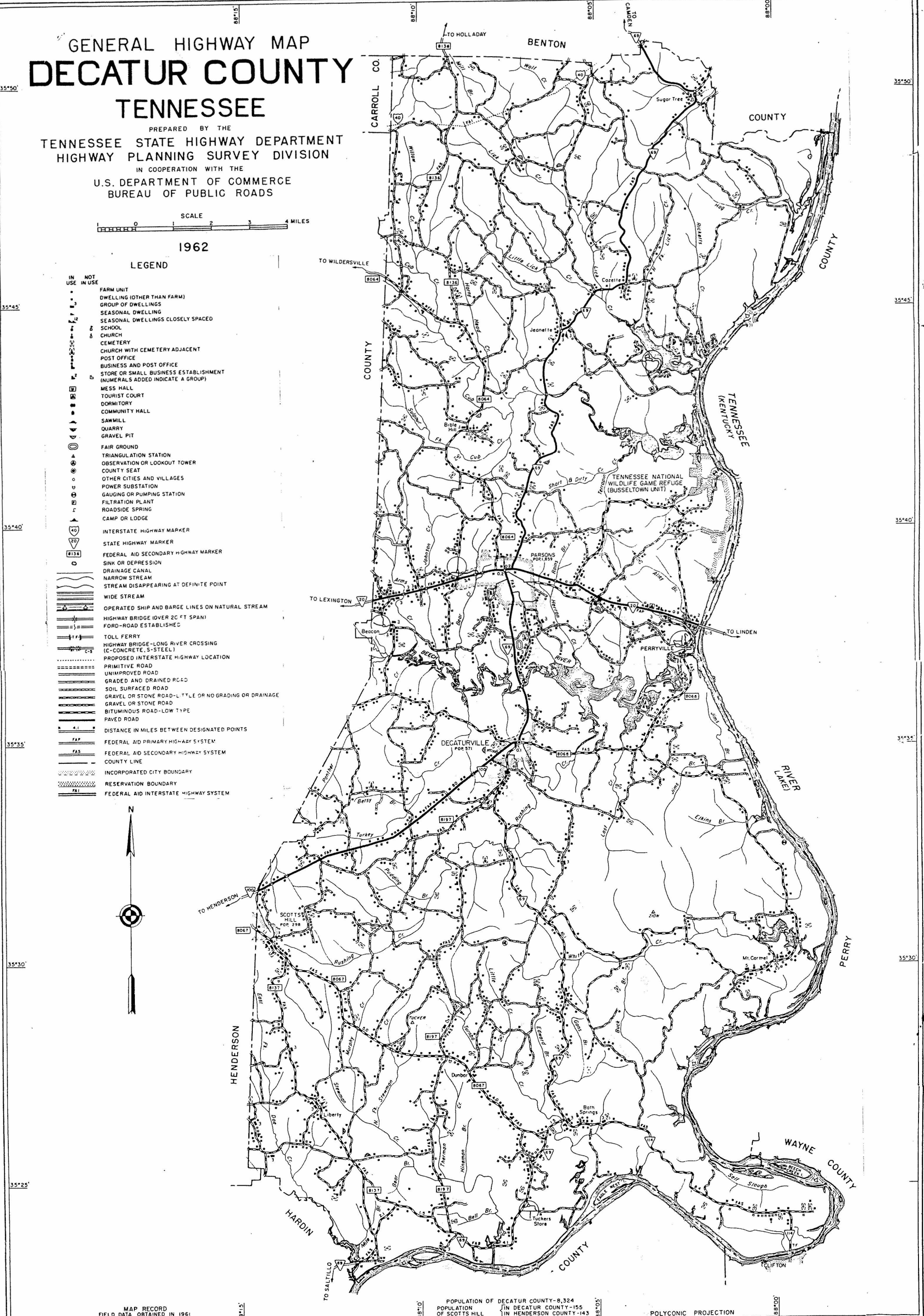
