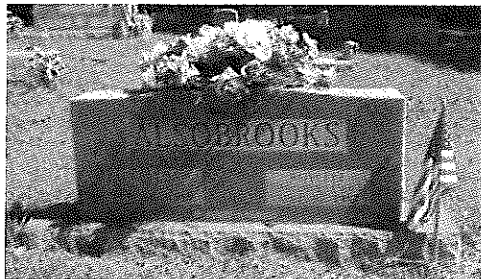
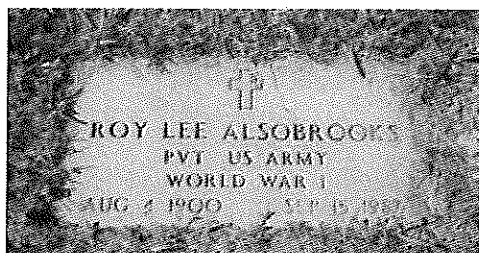

Roy Lee Alsobrooks, 87, Route 3, Erin, died Tuesday, Sept. 15, 1987, at Royal Care Nursing Home, Erin.

Funeral services were held Thursday, Sept. 17, 1987 at Campground Cumberland Presbyterian Church with the Rev. John Stiles officiating. Burial was in Alsobrooks Cemetery.


