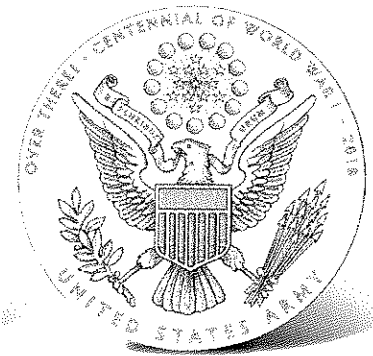

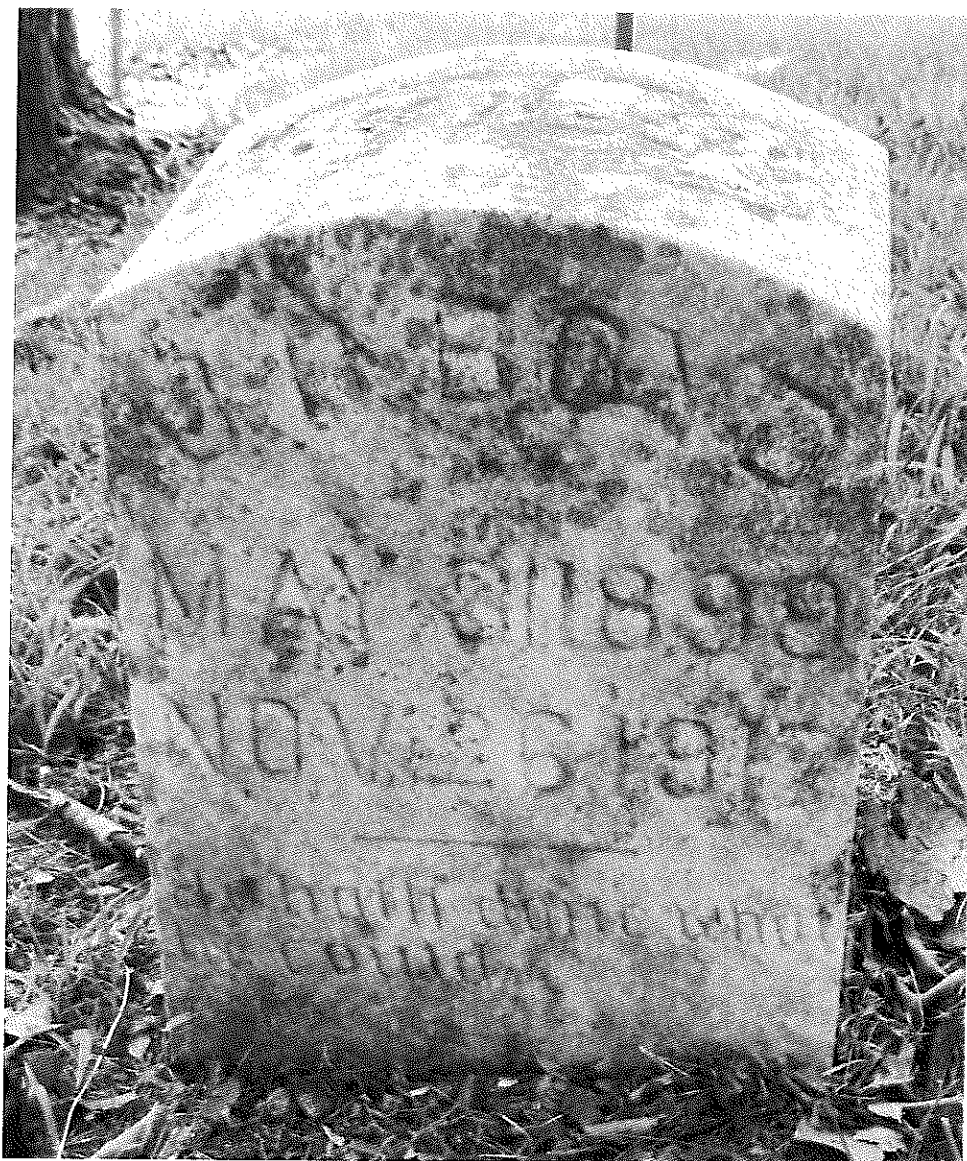

BERRY BOYD

May 31, 1899 – Nov. 26, 1917

May 31, 1899: J. B. "Berry" Boyd was born to J. Ambrose Boyd and Louisa Jane Nash.

April 6, 1917: U. S. entered WWI.

June 5, 1917: The first Selective Service Draft Registration was held nationwide for men 21 to 30 years old. Berry Boyd was only 18 years old. His older brothers, Jesse and William A. Boyd both registered at Carlisle in Stewart County.

July 25, 1917: 18 year old Berry Boyd enlisted in the National Guard at Cumberland City, TN with his 24 year old brother, Jesse Boyd. Their 23 year old brother, William A. Boyd had enlisted there a month before on June 25, 1917. They were all three assigned to Company A 2nd TN Infantry National Guard and sent to the National Guard Training Camp at Camp Sevier, Greenville, S. C.

Sept. 19, 1917: Co A 2nd TN Infantry NG was absorbed by Co L 119th Infantry Regiment 30th Division 2nd Corp National Army when it was established at Camp Sevier.

Oct 1-12, 1917: The three Boyd Brothers along with all the other Houston County men in Co. A 2nd TN Infantry NG were transferred to Co L 119th Infantry.

Early November 1917: 3000 cases of measles were reported at Camp Sevier. The camp was under quarantine for 3 weeks.

Nov. 26, 1917: Berry Boyd died of pneumonia probably from complications from the measles. Roger W. Spears, a Houston County soldier in his Company, died the same day. One can imagine how devastating a measles outbreak could have been 100 years ago, exacerbated by crowded conditions in Army Camps and spread by troop movements.

Berry Boyd's body was returned home to be buried in the Boyd Family cemetery.

May 12, 1918: Co L 119th Infantry was shipped overseas. They left Boston Harbor aboard the "Lamedon." Berry Boyd's brothers, Jesse and William A Boyd were among the 234 enlisted men in Company L. Sixteen of the men in Co L were from Houston County and 38 men were from surrounding counties.

Co L 119th Infantry 30th Division saw action in Ypree, Bellicourt, Busigny and St Souplet.

Bellicourt is where the 30th Division led the charge which broke the Hindenburg Line on Sept. 29, 1918, which by all accounts help shorten the war.

Oct. 17, 1918: William A Boyd was wounded but continued to serve. He returned home with his brother, Jesse and the other members of Co L 119th Infantry on **April 2, 1919**. They were both discharged **April 16, 1919** and returned home to Houston County, TN.

Nov. 11, 1918: Armistice signed.

Berry Boyd's sister, Sally Boyd Winters, had a brother-in-law who also served overseas in WWI. Andrew Jackson Winters served in Battery C 318 Field Artillery from Aug. 8, 1918 – June 11, 1919.

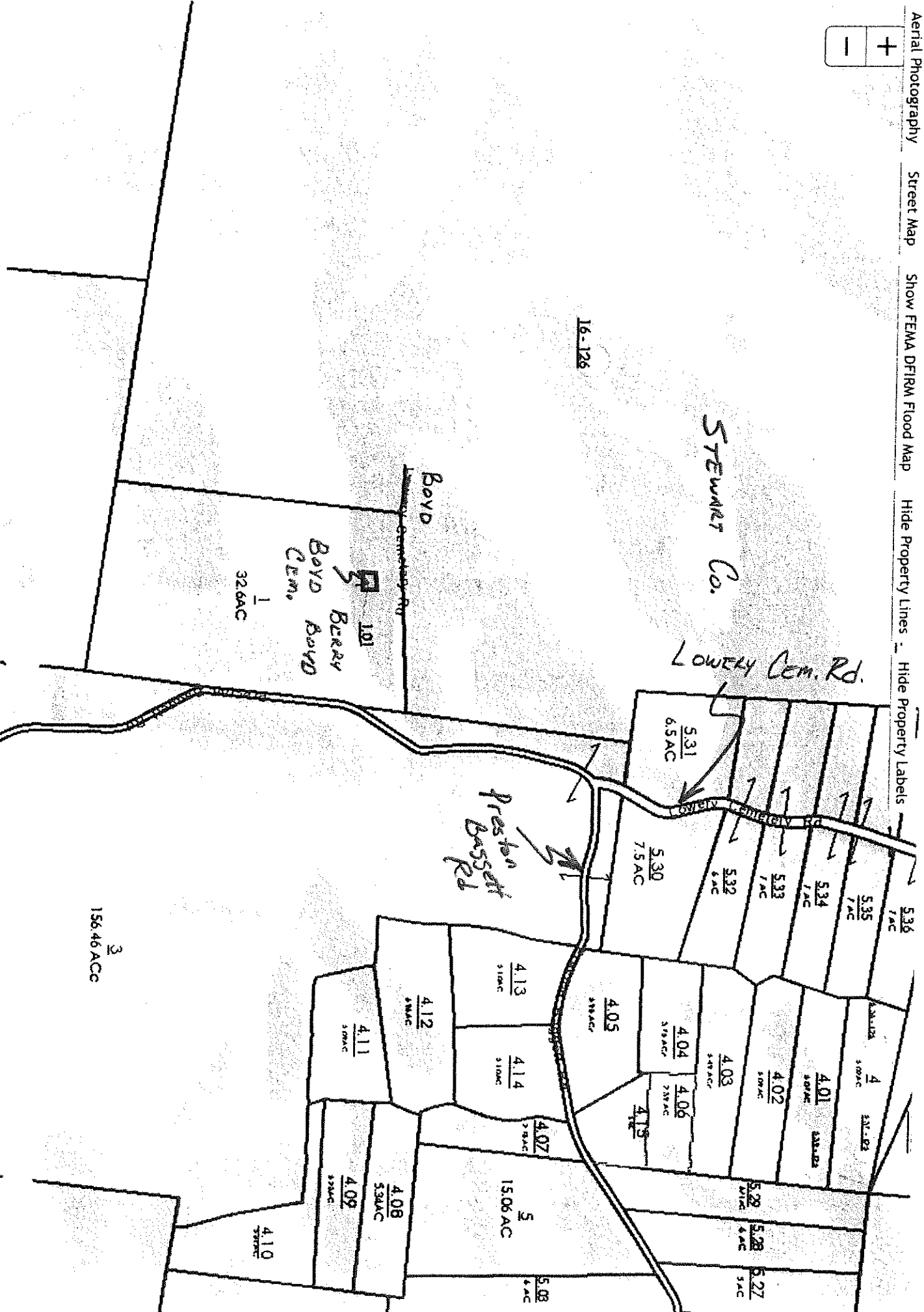
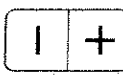
