## Sgt. Garfield's Services Held

Marine Sgt. Fredrick Grafried, died in Millington Naval Hospital Memphis, Feb. 24, 1951, following an illness of several months.

He was born April 6, 1885, at "Hawberry Farm" near Danville, son of the late Wm. F. and Mary Wabamaker Bauer Grafried and spent his life in Houston County, with the exception of his Marine service.

He joined the Marines Dec. 10, 1907, and was retired Nov. 1, 1937, with the rating of a platoon Sergeant. He was aboard the U. S. S. Pennsylvania when the U. S. Navy made the trip around the world in 1908.

He saw service in China during the Boxer rebellion; was with the Marines in old Mexico during the invasion by General John J. Pershing and after Panchovilla was in Nicaragua chasing Sandino.

During World War I he served in the West Indies at San Domingo guarding prisoners. During his service he crossed the Equator seven times and passed through the Panama Canal 17 times.

After retirement he was at home on the farm of his sister, Miss Clara Grafried, farm near Stewart. Surviving are two sisters, Miss Clara Grafried, a teacher in the Memphis schools, and Mrs. Beas Askew of McKinnon; one niece, Mrs. Eddie Cherry of Dover, and nephew, Billy Askew, Memphis.

Funeral services were held at the McKinnon Methodist Church, Feb. 26, at 2 p.m. by the Rev. James L. Davis and the Rev. Eunice Crow. Burial was in the McKinnon cemetery with Wiseman Funeral Home in charge.

Active pallbearers were Edgar Pitt, Ray Spurgeon, Eddie Cherry, Billy Askew, Elbert McGowan and Paul Lewis. Honorary pallbearers were: Dr. A. E. Averitt, Judge Charles Cherry, H. C. Yates, John L. Bradley, Louie Weaver, D. D. Askew, Looney Askew and Herbert McAulay.
