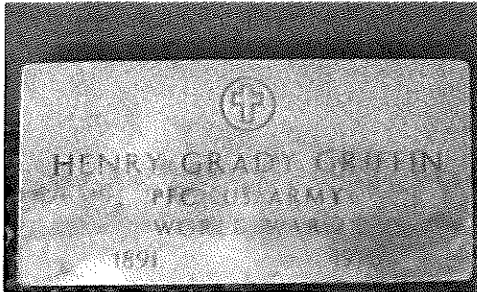

Funeral services for Henry Grady Griffin age 87, were conducted Thursday, December 28, 1978 at 2:00 p.m. at Nave's Erin Chapel by the Rev. Robert Mitchell, Rev. Robert Dixon and Rev. Paul Ford. Burial was in the Halliburton Cemetery.

A native of Houston County, Mr. Griffin was born August 8, 1891, son of the late William Griffin and Margaret Halliburton Griffin. He was a member of the Erin Nazarene Church and retired farmer of Route 3, Erin. He was a resident of Palmyra Intermediate Care Center at the time of his death.
