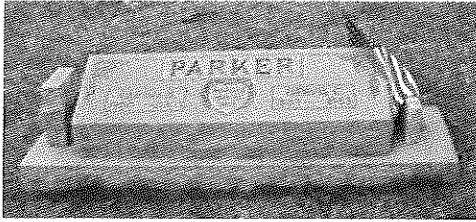

## Mr. Parker Dies; Rites Saturday

Funeral services for Gervis C. Parker, 74, were held Saturday August 10, at 2:00 p.m. at the Erin Methodist Church, which he was a member. Rev. James M. Davis, pastor, officiated. Burial was in the Cedar Valley Cemetery with Wiseman Funeral Home in charge.

Mr. Parker died at his home in Erin August 8th of a long illness. He was a veteran of WWI and a retired book salesman.

A native of Houston County, he was the son of the late Robert and Bettie Warden Parker, and was married to Miss Gertha Brooks who is his only survivor.
