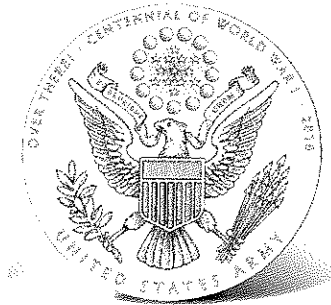

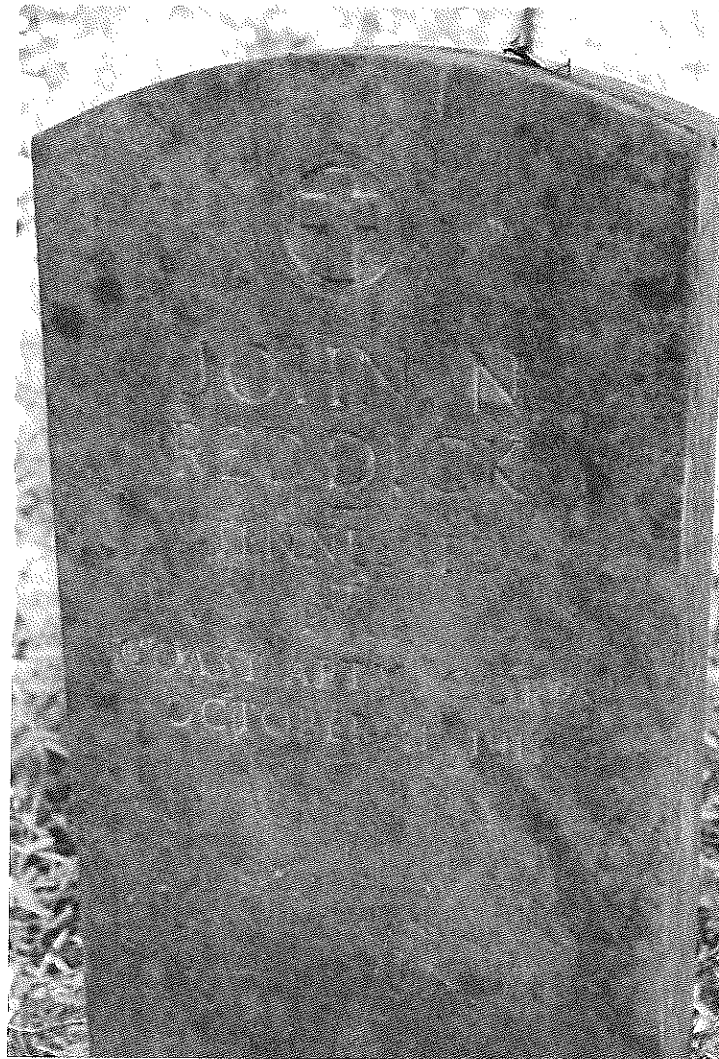

## JOHN N. REDDICK

1874 – October 11, 1917

**1874:** John N. Reddick was born in Erin, TN to William M. Reddick and Nancy R. Nelson. His father was a Civil War Veteran who fought for the Union. His mother died when he was 16 years old.

**1897:** married "Virgie" Powers

**1902:** A son, Carl Nelson Reddick, was born.

**1906:** A daughter, Virginia B. Reddick, was born.

**1910 Census:** John's estimated age was 36. He was a carpenter by trade, living near Ellis Mills in a rental house on a dairy farm with his wife and 2 children.

**April 6, 1917:** U.S. entered WWI

**May 1, 1917:** John enlisted in the Regular Army at Jefferson Barracks, MO, near St. Louis. He was assigned to the Coastal Artillery Corp at Ft. Greble, Rhode Island. He listed his age as 39 ½ years old. His estimated age from census records was 43.

**May 5, 1917:** Four days after John enlisted, his 19 year old half-brother, George D. Reddick, enlisted in the Regular Army at Ft. Oglethorpe, GA where he was assigned to the 17<sup>th</sup> Infantry where he served state side the duration of the war until he was discharged Feb. 10, 1919.

**May 14, 1917:** Less than two weeks after John enlisted, his brother-in-law, Condie Powers, enlisted in the Regular Army at Jefferson Barracks, MO. He served overseas with the 11<sup>th</sup> and 26<sup>th</sup> Infantry until he was KIA on Oct. 14, 1918. He is listed with Stewart County's War Dead.

**Oct. 11, 1917:** John became ill and was sent to the hospital in Bethesda, MD where he died, becoming the first Houston County native to die in service.

He was buried in the Reddick Family Cemetery in Ellis Mills.

According to Mr. Charles Crowe (who owns the farm where the Reddick Cemetery is located), someone in the Reddick family told him that William Reddick (b.1837) was a Yankee POW in Texas during the Civil War. He was being sent home to the Cincinnati, Ohio area up the Tennessee River. When the boat docked near Danville, TN, William got off the boat and reportedly told them, "That's as far as I am going to go." He married a woman from the Stewart area and bought a farm in Ellis Mills.
