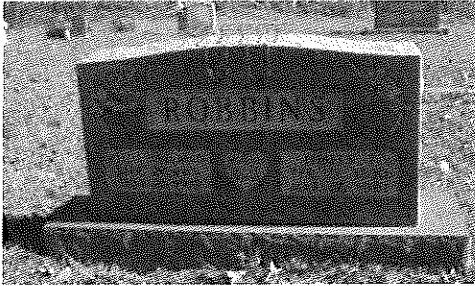
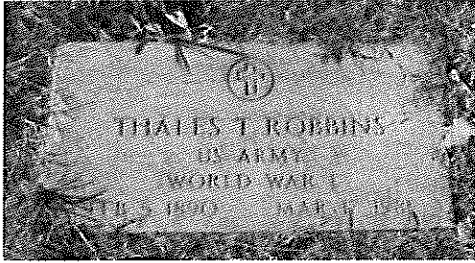

Thales Robbins

Services for Thales Thomas Robbins, 91, were conducted Thursday at 2 p.m. at Nave's Erin Chapel with the Rev. Thad Collier officiating. Burial was in the Batson Cemetery.

Mr. Robbins, of Route 3, Erin, died Tuesday at General Care Convalescent Center, Clarksville, after an extended illness. He was a retired farmer.

He was born Feb. 5, 1890, in McEwen, son of the late John Henry and Margaret Irene Brigham Robbins. He was married to the late Ruth Bateman Robbins.

He was a member of the Long Branch United Methodist Church, a U.S. Army veteran of World War I, and a member of the American Legion and the Houton County Farm Bureau.


