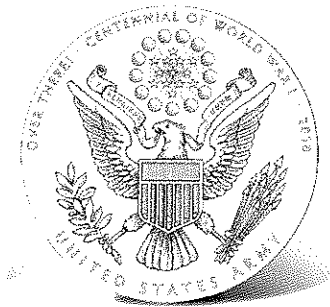

## OSCAR ROSS

1885 – Sept 13, 1918

**1885:** Oscar Ross born to Montgomery Stewart Ross (Gum) and Tennessee Tobitha Myers (Tennie).

**1910 census:** Oscar was 25 years old and living on Wells Creek Road in the Pollard community of Houston County, TN with his parents and 6 siblings.

**April 6, 1917:** U.S. entered WWI

**June 5, 1917:** The first Selective Service Draft was held nationwide for men 21 to 30 years old. Oscar was 32 years old.

**June 8, 1917:** Oscar enlisted in the National Guard in Memphis, TN. He listed his address at the time as the Oxford Hotel in Memphis. He stated he was 24 years old. Oscar was assigned to Battery A 1<sup>st</sup> Field Artillery TN National Guard.

**August/September 1917:** Battery A 1<sup>st</sup> Field Artillery TN National Guard was nationalized by the 114<sup>th</sup> Field Artillery 30<sup>th</sup> Division 2<sup>nd</sup> Corp National Army at Camp Sevier, S. C.

**May 26, 1918:** Oscar Ross was aboard the ship "Karoa" departing New York, New York as a member of Battery A 114<sup>th</sup> Field Artillery 30<sup>th</sup> Division.

**Sept. 12, 1918:** Men from the 114<sup>th</sup> FA aided the 353<sup>rd</sup> and 354<sup>th</sup> Artillery Brigades of the 89<sup>th</sup> Division (National Army) in the St. Mihiel Offensive where they achieved a depth of 21 kilometers and captured the towns of Beney, Essey, Boullionville, Pannes and Xammes.

**Sept 13, 1918:** Oscar Ross was KIA along with 3 other soldiers in a battle N. E. of Xammes, France. He was buried near the battlefield until his remains were brought home to TN and he was reburied in Ross #2 Cemetery on the Berry Sugg Farm off Hwy 13.

**Oct. 31, 1918 – July 16, 1919:** Oscar's brother, Walter Ross, Sr. also served overseas in WWI with the MD Evac Hosp 36.

**Nov. 11, 1918:** Armistice signed.

**Sept 12, 1919:** Walter Ross, Sr. was discharged with a 25% service connected disability.

Oscar's brother, Bee Ross, also served in the Army. He was stationed at Ft. Bliss, El Paso, TX.
