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## M. C. Webb Dies; Rites Wednesday

Funeral services for Murray C. Webb, 75, were held at the New Hope Cumberland Presbyterian Church at 2:00 p.m. Wednesday, February 12 with Rev. Jerry Lynch officiating. Burial was in the Summers cemetery with military rites at the graveside. Wiseman Funeral Home was in charge of arrangements.

Mr. Webb died Monday morning at his home in the New Hope Community of Houston County. He was a native of Stewart, Tennessee, son of the late Cullen and Julia Largent Webb. He was a farmer and timber worker and a veteran of WWI.

Surviving are his wife, Mrs. Ruby Allison Webb, four sons, Clyde and George Webb, Stewart Tennessee; Looney and Wendell Webb, Detroit, Mich.; six daughters, Barbara and Bonnie Webb of the home; Mrs. Mary Nickolal, Fremont, Calif.; Mrs. Ann Bridges, Mrs. Marvin Bradley and Mrs. Carolyn Hojnacki all of Detroit; four brothers, Robert Webb, Tennessee Ridge; Earl, Leonard and Marvin Webb, Detroit; three sisters, Mrs. Carl Walker, Erin; Mrs. Christine Smith, Centerline, Mich.; and Mrs. Irene Stone, Detroit; sixteen grandchildren also survive.
