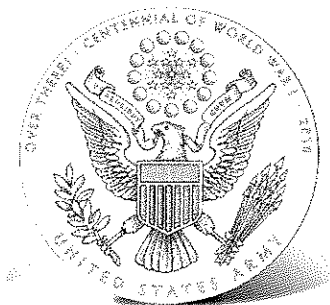

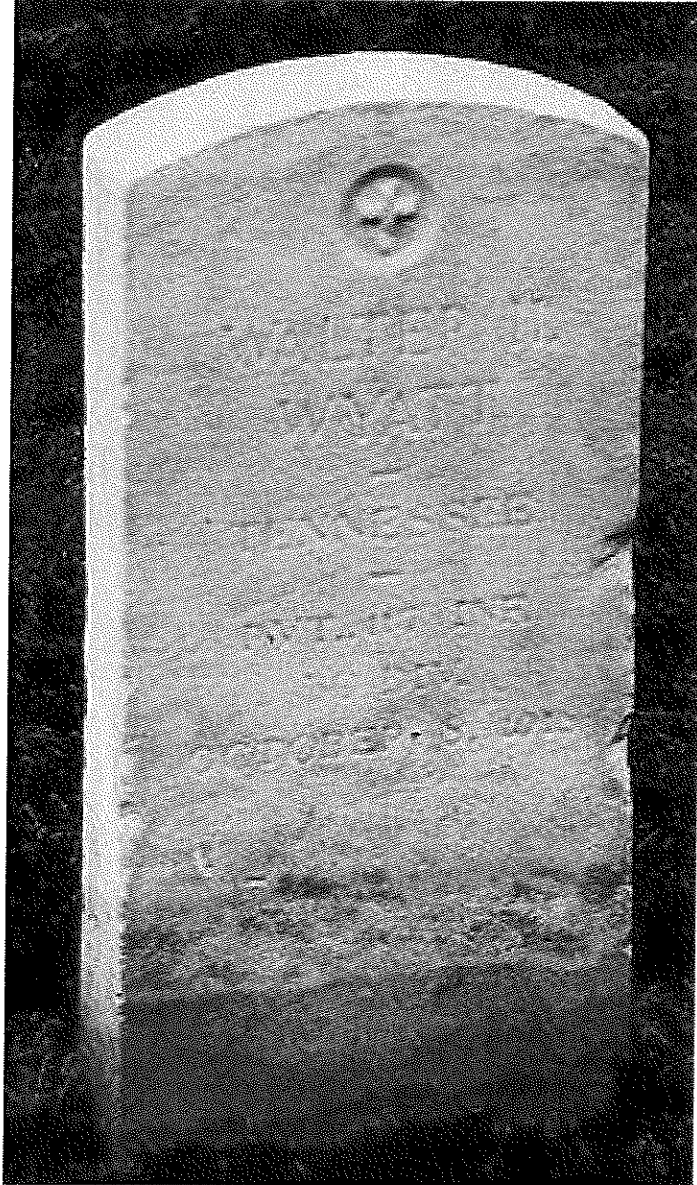

## **WALTER HOWARD WYATT**

Dec 10, 1892 – Oct 8, 1918

**Dec. 10, 1892:** Walter Howard Wyatt was born in Stewart County TN to Charles Sidney Wyatt and Nancy Chadwick.

**1900 Census:** He was 7 years old and living in Stewart County, TN with his parents and younger sister.

**Sept. 26, 1916:** Walter married Ruth Martin

**April 16, 1917:** The U. S. entered WWI.

**June 5, 1917:** Walter registered for the first Selective Service Draft at precinct # 12 in Stewart County.

**Early Sept. 1917:** The 117<sup>th</sup> infantry 59<sup>th</sup> Brigade 30<sup>th</sup> Division was formed at Camp Sevier, Greenville, S.C. The 117<sup>th</sup> Infantry was made up of volunteers with the 3<sup>rd</sup> TN Infantry and draftees, mainly from Camp Gordon. The 117<sup>th</sup> “enlisted personnel was about half draft and half volunteer.”

**Oct. 1, 1917:** Walter was sent to Camp Gordon, GA where he was reassigned to Co L 117<sup>th</sup> Infantry, 30<sup>th</sup> Division.

**May 11, 1918:** Departed New York, NY aboard the Anselm with Co L 117<sup>th</sup> Infantry. His wife, Ruth, was living in Stewart, TN.

Walter engaged in battle with the 117<sup>t</sup> Infantry at Bellicourt and Poncho.

**Oct. 8, 1918:** Walter Howard Wyatt died of wounds received in battle.

He was originally buried in the British Military Cemetery Somme, France.

**April 21, 1921:** Walter Howard Wyatt was reinterred at Arlington National Cemetery, Arlington, VA.


