To the Honorable the General Assembly of the State of Tennessee,

The Petition of a Number of the Citizens of Montgomery County Humbly Sheweth that whereas at your last General Assembly a law was passed making, or keeping open the Navigation of the West fork of Red River within our said County of Montgomery, which law we conceive Contrary to our interest & to the interest of the Publick at large because the stream will not admit of Navigation at any time but in a flood & the advantage of Mills would so far surpass that of Navigation we pray that your Honours would repeal the law as several Merchants Mills may be built on said Stream which will tend much to publick good
