

To the Senate and House of Representatives of the General Assembly of the State of Tennessee

The citizens of Montgomery County of Clarksville, beg leave to represent that they were last summer, respectfully invited by the people of Russellville and Logan County in the State of Kentucky to the subject of a Rail Road to be established between these two towns. Nothing material has yet been done. Committees of Correspondence have been appointed. And the Committee on the part of your citizens, has promised to endeavour to obtain from your honourable body an act to incorporate a company for the purpose of carrying into effect this great work. We shall not detain the legislature with a deliberation on the condition of the country for such an undertaking and of its very great importance when completed. We sincerely hope that the day is not far distant when it may be commenced with most flattering prospect of success. We deem it necessary that a company should be incorporated to act with full powers whenever the country may be in a situation to move directly onward in this business. We therefore, solicit your honourable body to give us a legal form, &c.
