

To the Honorable the General Assembly of the State of Tenn. Your petitioners represent that it would greatly conduce to the public convenience of the Citizens of the County of Montgomery, to authorize the organization of three Regts in said county instead of two as now exists by law - because of the unequal division which the Cumberland River makes of the County as well with regard to population as geography. At present the 9th Regt is divided almost equally by the River, and ⁱⁿ consequence of which the whole Regt cannot be got together without the greatest inconvenience - in order to avoid which, we petition for a special act of the next legislature, authorizing two Regts to be laid off on the north side, and one on the south side. Your petitioners represent that they believe there is population enough to make two complete Regts - on the north side - but not quite enough to make a full Regt on the south side of Cumberland.
