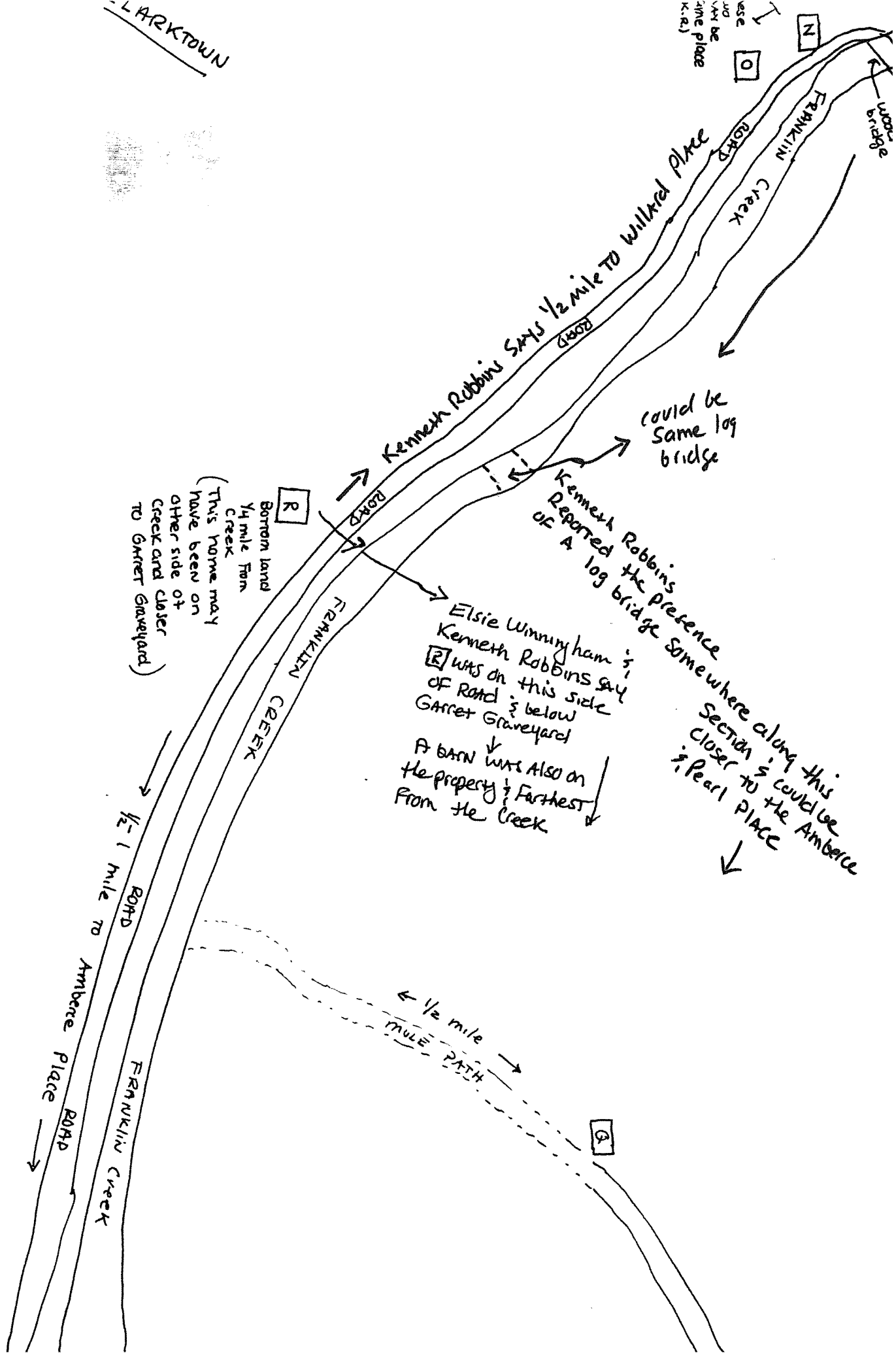

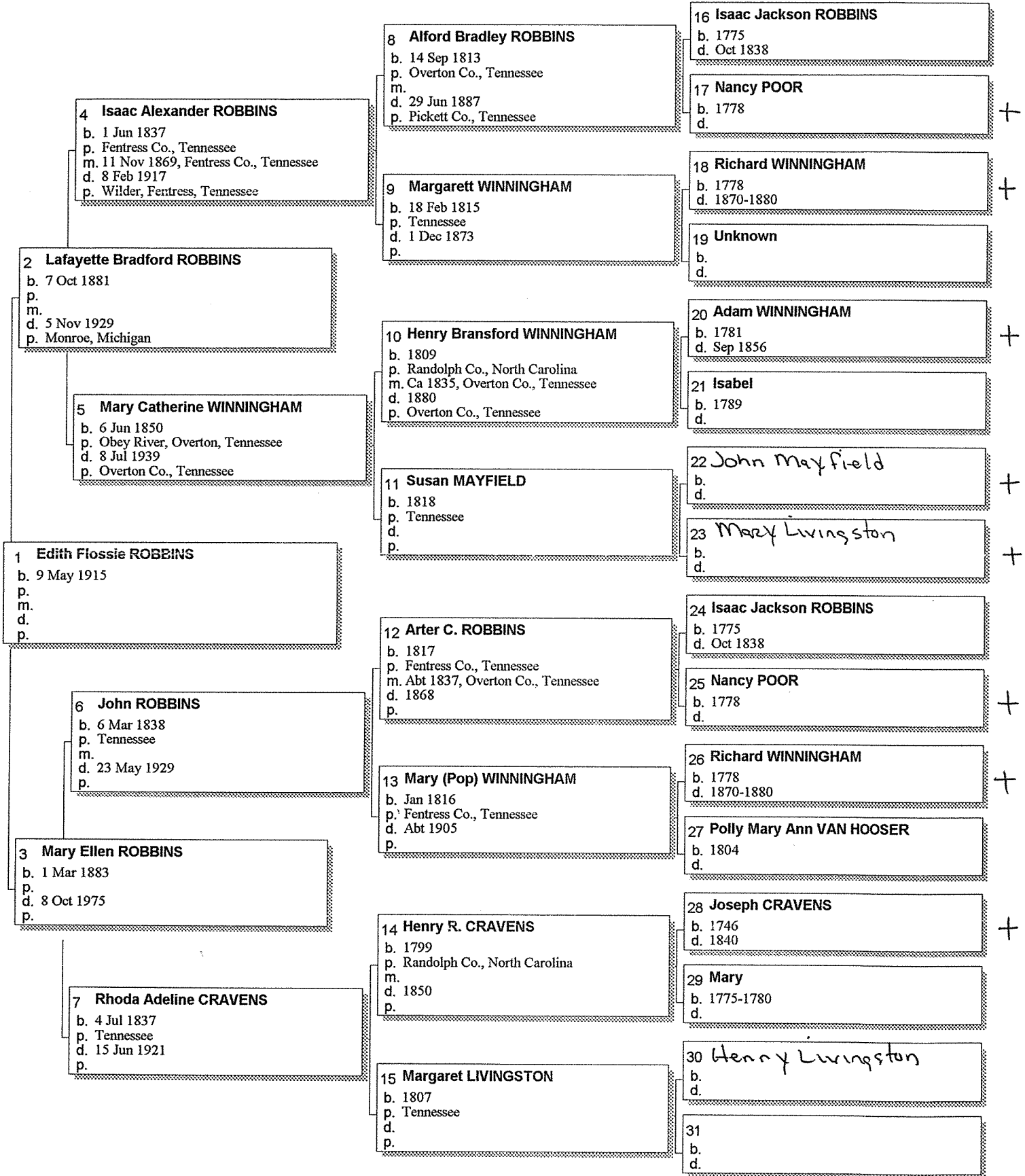

| E — | Cemetery. It is told that black (possibly black slaves) were buried here. The site was later plowed over by Audrey Byrd's son |
