William Feathers), was traveling through Texas many years ago; an elderly man recognized something familiar in him and asked if he were a Feathers. He was overjoyed when he found out he was a relative, and got the ticket agent to fix his ticket for a stop over, making James go home with him for the night. He told James his name was Frank Feathers, son of John L. Feathers, and a brother of William, David K., Samuel, Henry and etc; that he ran away from home when he was eighteen years old and had not heard from any of them since then. He showed James his large ranch and his cattle and tried to get James to stay with him. They corresponded for years and suddenly Frank quit writing and James decided he had died, as he was then getting very old."

The following is from newspaper clippings in the possession of Miss Allie M. Millard, daughter of Alvin Marion and Leonora Judith Hawkins Millard and grand-daughter of Joel D. and Barah Barbara Feathers Millard of Blountville, Tenn.

" The Feathers Family "

"David K. Feathers, living near Blountville, is in his 71st year—has lived within ten miles of this place nearly all his life——lived in Blountville, where the widow Susan Rogers now lives, from 1838 to 1853——built the house she lives in. There were no houses then in the East end of town higher up than where John Hicks lives.

"Mr. Feathers has five brothers living, to-wit: William, who lives near Carter's Depot, aged nearly 80—has a large family—married a Myers; Samuel, who lives about four miles from Jonesboro, Tenn.—has four children, all married; Henry, who lives five or six miles from same place, married a Hatcher; Jesse, who lives in West Tennessee; James, who lives at Wallace's Switch, Washington County, Va., married a Lyers in Sullivan—has a large family of children, all married but one; Nathan, an old bachelor, living with his widowed sister, Susan Watson, five miles southeast of Union.

"Mr. Feathers has five living sisters, to-wit: Caroline, who married William Cart, of Sullivan, and lives in Arkansas---

her husband is dead; Margaret, who married Elkanah Carr, lives on Indian Creek, about five miles from Union Depot; Susan, who married a Watson, had seven children, one dead. Mr. Watson died several years ago. The children are married, and the widow lives with her brother, Nathan Feathers; Sallie, who married Joel D. Millard, of Sullivan, raised a large family, and now lives in Blountville——four children single, two married, one a widow——two, George and Rebecca, are living at home.

"The father of the foregoing brothers and sisters was John L. Feathers, who was born in Albemarle County, Va., and came to Sullivan, when small, in company with his mother and step-father—was raised on the old John Peters farm, near Weaver's Church—married about the age of 21 to Barbara Sharrett. They had 16 children—four dead and not mentioned in this article. John, the father of John L. Feathers, and grandfather to David K. Feathers, came from Ireland, and settled in Albemarle County, Va. Hence the Feathers family are of Irish descent.

"The mother of John Foust, Catherine, was a sister to
John L. Feathers. Andrew Crockett married Christiana,
another sister of John L. Feathers. Nellie, the third sister
of John L. Feathers, married a Stewart and moved to Alabama.
The fourth sister of John L. Feathers married a Clark and has

been lost sight of.

"David K. Feathers was first married to Rebecca Millard, a daughter of Timothy and Elizabeth Millard, and became the parents of seven sons and three daughters. Three sons and one daughter are dead. The living ones are as follows:

Alvan, who is a physician lives at Rogersville Junction,

Tenm.; George A. Feathers, who has been a merchant, but is about to turn farmer, lives at Lancaster, Ky.; William and

Jonathan (Dock) live together on Beaver Creek, south of

Blountville; Sarah, the wife of John M. Galloway, who live on the old Galloway farm, near Tally's Ford of Holston River—post office, Boring's; Ellen, the wife of George W. Beard,

living on the said Galloway farm, just named. David K.

Feathers' first wife died about 1861. His second wife was

Lorotta Hinshew, by whom he has five living children—ages ranging from two to thirteen years.

"The mother of David K. Feathers was a Sharrett, born in Pennsylvania, and came to Sullivan at the age of eleven. She helped to plant out the orchard on the Reeve farm, near Paperville. Her mother was a Leedy, and came from Germany, and hence the Feathers family are of German as well as Irish descent.

(Note by Allie M. Millard: The above newspaper clipping is undated, but is probably from the old "Blountville Star",

or whatever the name of Uncle Noah Phillips! paper was, when he was editor of the paper in Blountville) — (Also see "Central Star", Jan. 12, 1882, Blountville, Tennessee, by Geo. A. Feathers,—N. J. Phillips, Editor). Last quoted parenthesis is a note found on the margin of the above quoted clipping, and it may be is the reference to this same clipping, or it may refer to some other information there obtainable.
