- Illustrations and copyrights get permission pre 1922 is public domain, post 1922 is not, government websites okay to copy
- Indexing critical, must have index, consider "Sky" indexing
- program, but best method is still manual indexing
- Ideas
 - o Transcription = verbatim, Abstract = selected info, be sure to indicate which
 - o Feature historic houses
 - o Include some genealogy but add biography or stories to make more interesting
 - o Methodology how to research, e.g., deeds
- 3. Publishing
- Profit balance investment and return, consider presale of special publications
- Choosing topics
- Marketing and distribution get list of libraries mailing info/labels from TSLA
- Advertise on eBay or Amazon
- Indexing include names, topics, places, consider a cumulative index, put your index online
- 4. Send info about events and sales to MTGS for their newsletter

Join the 34 recipients who just received Certificates for Warren County - McMinnville First Pioneer Families

To qualify for a certificate, suitable for framing, the applicant must directly descend from an ancestor (male or female) who was in Warren County no later than the 1820 census (this includes the boundaries of the original formation of Warren County from White county).

Proof can be established by submitting copies of an official record, i.e. birth, marriage, death, probate or will, church, cemetery, funeral or obituary, land recodes, tax records, court, military records, census, newspaper, or Bible for each generation, including the applicant. Current Tennessee residency is not necessary.

There is a \$10 application processing fee + \$3.50 shipping for the certificates. All applications and verifying material become the property of the Warren County Genealogical Association.
